Visiativ, a publisher of innovative software platforms and Europe's leading integrator of Dassault Systèmes solutions, has announced the launch of a new strategic business for the Rapid Manufacturing and 3D printing sectors, designed to support SMEs and mid-tier companies in their transition to Industry 4.0. This new business goes hand in hand with the services Visiativ already provides to its 14,000 clients via its Moovapps and SolidWorks products and the 3DEXPERIENCE platform.

As part of the launch of this new business, Visiativ is pleased to announce:

- (i) the acquisition of an interest in growth company Valla, which specialises in rapid prototyping, rapid tooling and high temperature injection moulding of parts, from prototypes to small batches;
- (ii) the signature of a business partnership with HP in the field of 3D printing; and
- (iii) the consolidation of its long-term relationship with Dassault Systèmes to promote and develop the factory of the future.

Visiativ is launching its phygital platform for Rapid Manufacturing

3D printing, which has in the past been used only for design and rapid prototyping, is now evolving to become part of the core industrial production processes of SMEs and mid-tier companies, thanks to the arrival of more robust and efficient machines and the convergence of CAD (computer-aided design) software tools, process management systems and manufacturing.

With its Moovapps software platform, the first catalogue of business applications designed to step up the digital transformation of companies, and its long-standing partnership with Dassault Systèmes, Visiativ is primed to enter this additive manufacturing market. To this end, the Group is announcing its phygital platform for Rapid Manufacturing, based on a comprehensive offer combining digital design and physical objects.





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A financial and operational partnership with Valla

With a view to supporting its new business venture into the field of Rapid Manufacturing, Visiativ identified Valla, a company based near Lyon (France), as the best partner with all of the necessary expertise (prototyping, tooling and batch manufacturing) for this ambitious growth project.

Founded in 1961 and acquired by its current CEO Sacha Tolegano Jourdren in 2015, Valla specialises in Rapid Manufacturing. It supports SMEs, mid-tier companies and key accounts with the design, prototyping and manufacture of parts using 3D printing, machining and injection, drawing on the unique know-how of its 25 employees. In 2016, the company generated a total turnover of €2.5 million.

As part of a commercial and operational partnership, the two companies are launching a joint venture under the name Visiativ 3D Printing, with the aim of driving forward their development on the Rapid Manufacturing and 3D printing market.

To complete the deal, Visiativ has also acquired a minority interest of 20% in Valla's parent company. Valla and Visiativ have agreed that Visiativ will gradually build up its stake in the parent company with a view to becoming the majority shareholder.

"This sharing of knowledge between Visiativ and Valla is an excellent opportunity to bring the potential afforded by 3D printing to SMEs and mid-tier companies. With Valla's technological know-how in Rapid Manufacturing and Visiativ's proven expertise in the digital transformation of industrial companies, we will be able to provide the most appropriate response to our clients' needs," explained Sacha Tolegano Jourdren, Chief Executive Officer of Valla.

Distribution agreement for HP 3D printers

Visiativ is also pleased to announce the signature of a business partnership between Visiativ 3D Printing and HP in relation to HP's range of industrial 3D printers. The agreement represents an additional step in Visiativ's expansion into Rapid Manufacturing. Visiativ chose to partner with HP for its ambition - in so far as HP aims to become the world's leading provider of industrial 3D printing services and is prepared to invest to achieve that aim - and for the quality of its technology.

The US firm's 3D printing solutions make it possible to produce functional thermoplastic parts much more rapidly than with other existing technologies; the process is more reliable (in terms of repeatability) and streamlined, with automated components. Everything is in place to allow for full batch production.

"We are looking forward to beginning this new business relationship in 3D printing with the Visiativ group, already a long-standing partner of HP France. Visiativ's position in the digital transformation market goes hand in hand with our strategy for expanding the use and applications of our HP Multi Jet Fusion 3D technology far beyond the limits of standard additive manufacturing," explained Emilio Juarez, EMEA Sales Director for HP's 3D printing business.

With this in mind, Dassault Systèmes and Visiativ have agreed to extend their partnership with respect to industrial SMEs and mid-tier companies, via the 3DEXPERIENCE platform.
